FIRST-TIME APPLICANTS

To be eligible for the A.G.C.A. Scholarship applicants must complete the requirements listed below and return the completed application along with all supporting documents by the due date. All requirements must be met in order to be considered for the scholarship. Completed packets must be hand-delivered to a current AGCA Board Member by the due date or mailed with a postmark by the due date.

Requirements:

- Must be sponsored by a current AGCA member who has participated in at least two (2) AGCA tournaments in the current year including one (1) of the AGCA Scholarship Tournaments *
- Must have volunteered a minimum of four hours to the AGCA within the last 12 months as verified by the AGCA Board *
- Complete the undergraduate scholarship application for the current year *
- Provide a brief (250 words or less) letter of recommendation from the AGCA member sponsoring the applicant
- Provide High School transcript if just graduated OR current college transcript (must show GPA)
- Provide proof of registration from the college or university attending

RETURNING APPLICANTS

Individuals who have previously applied for the AGCA Scholarship may re-apply for a scholarship by completing the requirements listed below and returning the completed application with supporting documents by the due date. All requirements must be met in order to be considered for the scholarship. Completed packets must be hand-delivered to a current AGCA Board Member by the due date or mailed with a postmark by the due date.

Requirements:

- Must be sponsored by a current AGCA member who has participated in at least two (2) AGCA tournaments in the current year including one (1) of the AGCA Scholarship Tournaments *
- Must have volunteered a minimum of four hours to the AGCA within the last 12 months as verified by the AGCA Board *
- Complete the undergraduate scholarship application for the current year *
- Provide a current college/university/trade school transcript (must show GPA)
- Provide proof of registration from a College, University, or Trade School in which he/she is currently enrolled

The AGCA member must have actively participated in at least two (2) of the AGCA tournaments during the current year and must include one of the two scholarship tournaments. All applicants must have volunteered a minimum of four hours to the AGCA within the last 12 months. All applicants must meet all requirements for new applicants and renewals as outlined in the current year scholarship application and submit their application and all required items by the required date to be considered.
